Is It Wrong To Aspire Greatness?

- This God-given longing for greatness has been corrupted by sin into a longing not to be great, but:
 - To be **known** as **GREAT**;
 - To be **GREATER THAN** someone else

Is It Wrong To Aspire Greatness?

- Instead of destroying it, Jesus radically transforms it.
- But the path is down, not up.

1. True Greatness Is The Willingness To Be Last (LAST OF ALL)

- We act out of our selfish desires at the expense of others.
- We develop volumes of pride at our accomplishments.
- We constantly compare ourselves with whoever we perceive to be somewhat less successful than us.

1. True Greatness Is The Willingness To Be Last (LAST OF ALL)

- To what degree has the impulse to self-exaltation been crucified?
- How much heartfelt desire to serve others has there been?
- How much readiness and willingness to decrease while others increase?

2. True Greatness Is The Willingness To Serve Everyone (Servant of All)

- It is not positioning yourself so that others praise you.
- True greatness is putting yourself in a position to serve everyone—to be a blessing to as many as you possibly can.

2. True Greatness Is The Willingness To Serve Everyone (Servant of All)

- Why children?
 - A child has no influence at all.
 - A child does not give reciprocally
- Stop chasing the bubbles of man's praise and start pursuing God

2. True Greatness Is The Willingness To Serve Everyone (Servant of All)
